

Administration/Classroom Building (A)

Admissions, Advising and Transfer Center, Student Life, Financial Aid, Records and Registration offices branch off the Babylon Great Hall.

Classroom Building (C)

Classroom Building (K)

7 Steps to Becoming a Carroll Student

1. Complete Enrollment Application

Apply online for free at carrollcc.edu/applynow or in the Admissions Office.

2. Take Placement Tests

Your Day

English, reading and math skills placement testing is available on a walk-in basis in the Admissions Office, starting in February for fall and October for spring. Prepare for your placement test at carrollcc.edu/testprep. (Your SAT and ACT scores may exempt you from placement testing.) Visit our website for details.

3. Post-test Advising

Right after you test, you will go to the Admissions Office to pick up and discuss your placement test results with an admissions counselor or advisor. Based on this discussion, you will either return for additional testing, or you will be ready to meet with an academic advisor and register.

4. Register for Courses

Your advisor will help you select and register for your courses.

5. Pay Tuition

You have several options to help you pay for college. For more information, speak with a staff member in our Financial Aid Office.

6. Prepare for Class

Preview your classes and make any schedule adjustments before classes begin. Go to New Student Orientation and discover what opportunities Carroll has to help you be a successful college student. Buy your books.

7. Start Your Adventure!

Go to your classes the first day they meet. (Attending the first class is crucial.) Meet your professors. Make new friends. Learn and grow.

Finance Your Future

We are committed to making your education affordable with many financial aid, scholarship and payment plan options.

To determine eligibility for financial aid, first complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at **fafsa.ed.gov.** The school code for Carroll Community College is **031007.** This code must be entered to send your financial aid information to the college.

Complete the FAFSA each year beginning October 1. It is recommended that the FAFSA be filed between October 1 and February 20 to receive consideration for Maryland State grants. After February 20, Carroll applicants may still apply and will receive federal student aid based on eligibility.
